Re: Closure of Seaton Pool, Plymouth.

Thank you very much for your letter of the 5th of February 2006 which I received on the 8th. I am most grateful to you for following up our conversation on the telephone of the 2nd of February. I have indeed looked at the web site to which you referred, on my computer. Since then someone else has written and actually enclosed a print out. I am particularly grateful to you for sending the press clippings which flesh out the situation very usefully.

I confirm that I am fully in support in the campaign to keep Seaton Pool open, at least until such time as alternative facilities are up and running. I stress this because I do not think assurances about facilities to be built are a sufficiently good reason when the City is already ill served by the number of pools available.

I am writing both to the Regional Development Authority and the Chief Executive of Plymouth City Council letting them have my views and I am also issuing a press statement.
